**Jonah 3:1-5, 10**

- 3:1 The word of the LORD came to Jonah a second time, saying,
- 3:2 "Get up, go to Nineveh, that great city, and proclaim to it the message that I tell you."
- 3:3 So Jonah set out and went to Nineveh, according to the word of the LORD. Now Nineveh was an exceedingly large city, a three days' walk across.
- 3:4 Jonah began to go into the city, going a day's walk. And he cried out, "Forty days more, and Nineveh shall be overthrown!"
- 3:5 And the people of Nineveh believed God; they proclaimed a fast, and everyone, great and small, put on sackcloth.
- 3:10 When God saw what they did, how they turned from their evil ways, God changed his mind about the calamity that he had said he would bring upon them; and he did not do it.

**Jeremiah 3:21 - 4:2**

- 3:21 A voice on the bare heights is heard, the plaintive weeping of Israel's children, because they have perverted their way, they have forgotten the Lord their God:
- 3:22 Return, O faithless children, I will heal your faithlessness. "Here we come to you; for you are the Lord our God.
- 3:23 Truly the hills are a delusion, the orgies on the mountains. Truly in the Lord our God is the salvation of Israel.
- 3:24 "But from our youth the shameful thing has devoured all for which our ancestors had labored, their flocks and their herds, their sons and their daughters.
- 3:25 Let us lie down in our shame, and let our dishonor cover us; for we have sinned against the Lord our God, we and our ancestors, from our youth even to this day; and we have not obeyed the voice of the Lord our God."

4:1 If you return, O Israel, says the Lord, if you return to me, if you remove your abominations from my presence, and do not waver,

4:2 and if you swear, "As the Lord lives!" in truth, in justice, and in uprightness, then nations shall be blessed by him, and by him they shall boast.
